1. Definitions

The data protection declaration of the SKM GmbH is based on the terms used by the European legislatio

In this data protection declaration, we use, inter alia, the following terms:

- a) **Personal data**

Personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (“data subject

- **b) Data subject**

Data subject is any identified or identifiable natural person, whose personal data is processed by the controller.

- **c) Processing**

Processing is any operation or set of operations which is performed on personal data or on sets of personal data.

- **d) Restriction of processing**

Restriction of processing is the marking of stored personal data with the aim of limiting their processing in the future.

- **e) Profiling**

Profiling means any form of automated processing of personal data consisting of the use of personal data to evaluate certain personal aspects, such as performance, reliability, creditworthiness, behavior, preferences, interests, and so on.

- **f) Pseudonymisation**

Pseudonymisation is the processing of personal data in such a manner that the personal data can no longer be attributed to a specific individual without the use of additional information, provided that such additional information is stored separately and is subject to technical and organizational measures to ensure that the personal data are not attributed to an identified or identifiable individual.

- **g) Controller or controller responsible for the processing**

Controller or controller responsible for the processing is the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data.

- **h) Processor**

Processor is a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which processes personal data on behalf of the controller.

- **i) Recipient**

Recipient is a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or another body, to which the personal data are disclosed, whether it acts in relation to the controller or not, and whether or not it is permitted to process the personal data.

- **j) Third party**

Third party is a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or body other than the data subject, con

- **k) Consent**

Consent of the data subject is any freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous indication of the dat

6. Rights of the data subject

- a) Right of confirmation

Each data subject shall have the right granted by the European legislator to obtain from the controller th

- **b) Right of access**

Each data subject shall have the right granted by the European legislator to obtain from the controller free of charge the following information:

- the purposes of the processing;
- the categories of personal data concerned;
- the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed;
- where possible, the envisaged period for which the personal data will be stored, or, if not possible, the criteria used to determine that period;
- the existence of the right to request from the controller rectification or erasure of personal data, or restriction of processing;
- the existence of the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
- where the personal data are not collected from the data subject, any available information as to their source;
- the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, referred to in Article 22(1) and (4) and the logic involved in such decision-making.

Furthermore, the data subject shall have a right to obtain information as to whether personal data are transferred to a third party.

If a data subject wishes to avail himself of this right of access, he or she may, at any time, contact any employee designated for this purpose in the contact information.

- **c) Right to rectification**

Each data subject shall have the right granted by the European legislator to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her.

If a data subject wishes to exercise this right to rectification, he or she may, at any time, contact any employee designated for this purpose in the contact information.

- **d) Right to erasure (Right to be forgotten)**

Each data subject shall have the right granted by the European legislator to obtain from the controller the erasure of personal data concerning him or her where one of the following conditions applies:

- The personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or processed;
- The data subject withdraws consent to which the processing is based according to point (a) of Article 6 of the GDPR or point (a) of Article 9 of the GDPR, and there is no other legal basis for the processing;
- The data subject objects to the processing pursuant to Article 21(1) of the GDPR and there are no overriding legitimate grounds for the processing;
- The personal data have been unlawfully processed;
- The personal data must be erased for compliance with a legal obligation in Union or Member State law to which the controller is subject;
- The personal data have been collected in relation to the offer of information society services referred to in Article 8(3) of the GDPR.

If one of the aforementioned reasons applies, and a data subject wishes to request the erasure of personal data concerning him or her, he or she may at any time contact any employee of the SKM GmbH.

Where the controller has made personal data public and is obliged pursuant to Article 17(1) to erase the data, the controller will take all reasonable steps to inform other controllers processing the data that they should erase the data. The controller will also inform the data subject of those other controllers, if the controller is aware of them.

- **e) Right of restriction of processing**

Each data subject shall have the right granted by the European legislator to obtain from the controller restriction of the processing of his or her personal data under the following conditions:

- The accuracy of the personal data is contested by the data subject, for a period enabling the controller to verify the accuracy of the data;
- The processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests the restriction of its processing instead;
- The controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but they are required by the data subject for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims;
- The data subject has objected to processing pursuant to Article 21(1) of the GDPR pending the verification of the claims of the data subject.

If one of the aforementioned conditions is met, and a data subject wishes to request the restriction of the processing of his or her personal data, he or she may at any time contact any employee of the SKM GmbH.

- **f) Right to data portability**

Each data subject shall have the right granted by the European legislator, to receive the personal data concerning him or her, which he or she has provided to the controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. Where technically feasible, the data should be transmitted directly from one controller to another.

Furthermore, in exercising his or her right to data portability pursuant to Article 20(1) of the GDPR, the data subject may request the controller to restrict the processing of his or her personal data to the extent necessary to carry out the exercise of his or her right to data portability.

In order to assert the right to data portability, the data subject may at any time contact any employee of the SKM GmbH.

- **g) Right to object**

Each data subject shall have the right granted by the European legislator to object, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, to the processing of his or her personal data by the controller for the following purposes:

The SKM GmbH shall no longer process the personal data in the event of the objection, unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject, or for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims.

If the SKM GmbH processes personal data for direct marketing purposes, the data subject shall have the right to object to the processing of his or her personal data.

In addition, the data subject has the right, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, to object to the processing of his or her personal data.

In order to exercise the right to object, the data subject may contact any employee of the SKM GmbH. In

- **h) Automated individual decision-making, including profiling**
